What's happening :

- On May 25 our Level 2 status was reviewed
- Gatherings of up to 100 people will be permitted from May 29
- June 8 is the next review date
- It is likely we will remain at Level 2 for four weeks
- Schools continue to operate with increased hygiene measures and physical distancing (where possible)
- Domestic travel continues and most businesses can reopen if they maintain the physical distancing policy
- Our international borders remain closed until further notice

What does this mean for your child:

- Sports practices and games can resume
- Student tours to South Island and North Island destinations can resume
- It is now easier to interact with friends and to continue with their education as planned

Essential:

- The NZ COVID tracer app needs to be downloaded to their smartphone
- Frequent handwashing and physical distancing remain a priority
