Waihi College is a 10 minute drive from stunning Waihi Surf Beach (9km long), 45 minutes from the vibrant city of Tauranga, 1 hour 30minutes from Auckland International Airport, 1 hour 20 minutes from Hamilton and 2 hours from the spectacular cultural city of Rotorua. 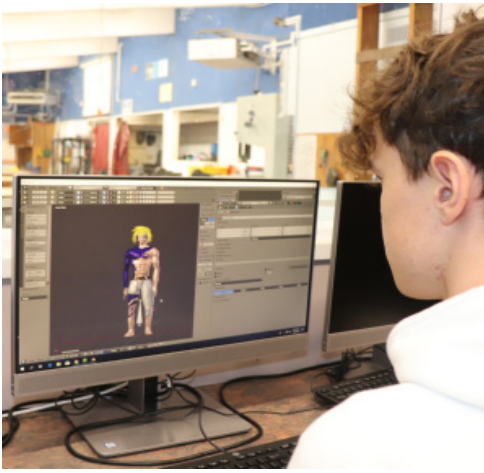
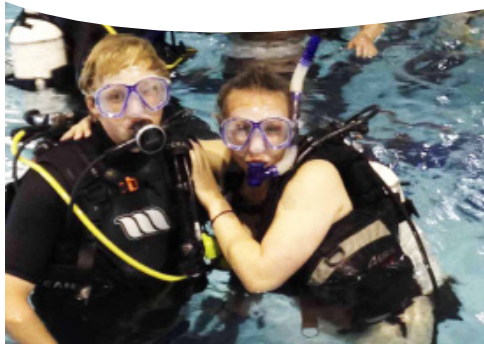
